APPLICATIONS REMINDER: Use the NEW Supplement A and make sure SPOUSE signs it! (See **Section D** above)

 917-639-0645 – e-FAX for SPEND-DOWN or SURPLUS UNIT — may submit pooled trusts here as well as bills. If pay spend-down for ONE MONTH Medicaid activated for SIX MONTHS (pandemic rule).
